## IMPORTANT RANSFEROTES

- x Webster has a minimum residency requirement that 30 of the student's last 36 credits must be taken at Webster University. All students must have a minimum of 128 credit hours to graduate.
- x Transfer students can apply up to 15 credit hours of approved coursework in the respective major from another institution. Students may transfer in-**6** credit hours of approved **fe**ign language coursework to meet the International language requirement.
- x Within each major, a specified number of credits must be uppeel.
  - Criminology majors must take a minimuof 18 hours at the 300 level, of which 6 hoursmust be 4000 level.
  - Anthropology majors must take a minimum 24
